It is a flexible programme, sub-divided into 3 certification levels: Award, Certificate or Diploma.

As the programme takes account of the content of past and present Army CLM programmes through a process known as the accreditation of prior learning (APL), learners at various ranks are exempted from some if not most of the modules required at each level. This greatly reduces the amount of work required.

SNCOs can readily achieve the Level 5 Award and Certificate in Professional Management Studies. If they wish to, they can then undertake additional modules, with only 3 more required to gain the full Level 5 Diploma in Professional Management Studies. Those attending the current Army CLM course at AECs should only need to do an extra 4 hours work to gain these 2 qualifications.

WOs can readily achieve the full Level 5 Diploma in Professional Management Studies. Those attending the current Army CLM course at AECs should only need to do an extra 4 hours work to gain this third – and highest – qualification.
